

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1934 OF 2016

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 141, ARTICLE I, SUB-SECTION 141-4
CANVASSING, PEDDLING AND SOLICITING OF THE GALLOWAY
TOWNSHIP CODE**

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the Township of Galloway to protect the safety of its residents and to prevent fraud from being perpetrated upon them and to protect them from criminal activity, while not inappropriately interfering with the exercise of free speech.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council for the Township of Galloway, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that Chapter 141 Canvassing, Peddling and Soliciting, Article 1 Canvassers and Door to Door Salesmen, Sub-Section 141-4 Application Information is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 141-4, paragraph I, is revised to read as follows:
 - I. Each applicant for registration shall submit to a criminal history name check from the New Jersey State Bureau of Identification in the New Jersey State Police. The applicant for registration shall pay to the Township the cost imposed by the New Jersey State Police for such a criminal history name check and a non-refundable fee to the Township of \$50.00. The report must cover the five (5) years preceding the application and in the event that the report reveals any prior convictions for crimes or offenses which in the judgment of the Chief of Police would negatively impact the safety of the public, the Chief of Police shall disapprove the application. The registration shall be valid for sixty days (60) from the date of the approval of the application.
2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
3. To the extent that any part or parts of this Ordinance are repealed or otherwise modified or voided by State Statute or case law, the remaining portions or sections of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
4. If any section, sentence or any part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of the Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication according to law, except as provided in for N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181.
